

Video mapping: The Odyssey of Hô

From June 29 to August 27, the famous cliffs of Fécamp will be adorned with a spectacular projection! Visible from the walkway dike/walkway of Fécamp, this free show is open to all and will immerse the public in an enchanted and fascinating universe.

The Odyssey of Hô

Initiated by OLVEA's Philanthropic Fund, which finances this mapping, the Fécampois scriptwriter Julien Clugery and the company Cookies Production will embark the audience in an entertaining, poetic and artistic experience based on the imaginative world of tales, through the journey of a child: Hô.

She undertakes an **interstellar journey** across 4 worlds: *The Planet of Winds, The Planet of Water, The Planet of Seasons* and the *Planet Earth*. Faithfully supported by a metamorphic "drop" that symbolizes her consciousness, she undertakes **a trip strewn with pitfalls** against which **analysis**, **imagination** and **resilience** will enable her to overcome the challenges she goes through, with courage and wisdom.

Between philosophical and humanistic tale, this fabulous story invites us to a reflection on life experiences as well as to environmental awareness.

A unique monumental experience

Beyond a beautiful story, The Odyssey of Hô is an **exploration** in which spectators will embrace the cliffs thanks to the technology of "video mapping". This process will immerse the public in the heart of this universe, and will transform our coastline into a unique and new space of expression. This type of projection on the colossal and sumptuous white chalk cliffs is a **big premiere**: the perfect combination between digital imagery and nature will highlight **Fécamp's coastline** as you have never seen it before!

This original projection uses the process of anamorphosis, which is similar to an optical illusion and is defined by a surprising and particular perspective vision. As a matter of fact, due to the complex angle of the video projection, the optimal viewing area will be located between the restaurant Le Pavillon and the art school (former museum of Fécamp). This will allow the public to fully enjoy the images of this beautiful show.

Experience The Odyssey of Hô and enjoy the magic of the show: children and adults will be amazed by this extraordinary adventure!

Who are we?

OLVEA's Philanthropic Fund aims to promote the cultural heritage in the region of Fécamp by encouraging and supporting the art creation through the restoration and acquisition of artworks. Since its creation in 2007, it has, among other projects, contributed to the restoration of the paintings in the church of Saint-Etienne and of the large stained glass window of the Abbey church. OLVEA's Philanthropic Fund has also offered the City of Fécamp three statues designed by the artist Dominique Denry, entitled "L'heure du bain", which are installed along the promenade of Fécamp.
